

## **PROHIBITED ITEMS AND CONDITION ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA**

### **PROHIBITED ITEMS**

The following items are prohibited from acceptance at any Alliance Recycling Group facility or subsidiary, except by special arrangement:

- Acetylene Cylinders
- Asbestos or Material Containing Asbestos – both fibrous and solids
- Any Material Containing Refrigerants (CFC or HCFC), unless the facility has agreed to recover refrigerants
- Cathode Ray Tubes (CRT/tube-style TV's or Computer Monitors)
- Closed Compressed Gas Cylinders – high pressure cylinders with valve intact
- Combustible or Flammable Materials – fuels, paints, degreasers, unpunctured aerosol cans
- Corrosive Materials, Munitions, Shell Casings – includes suspected military scrap
- Free Flowing Liquids (including water)
- Hazardous Wastes – toxic or poisonous items
- Infectious Materials – blood soaked or biohazard items
- Liquids or Scrap Containing Free Flowing Liquids – fuels, antifreeze, oils, hydraulic fluid, paints or water
- Mercury Containing Materials = mercury-containing thermostats, switches or fluorescent light bulbs
- Non-Metallic Items – concrete, wood, asphalt, dirt, debris, tires (more than 5 per auto)
- PCB Containing Materials
- Radioactive Material

### **CONDITIONAL ACCEPTANCE**

The following items are prohibited from acceptance at any Alliance Recycling Group facility or subsidiary, except by special arrangement:

- Autos – Coordinate with the independent facility
- Appliances – Coordinate with the independent facility

- Transformers – Unless otherwise agreed upon, transformers must be completely drained and have an analytical report that shows no PCB's
- Industrial Drums – Accepted if they are open top and completely empty with no solids, liquids or vapors, or are closed top and are empty or crushed so that no vapors can accumulate
- Propane Cylinders – Accepted if the valve has been removed or there are visible holes for inspection.
- AST or UST Tanks – Accepted if there are holes large enough to physically inspect interior of tanks to verify there is no sludge or combustible vapors present.
- Batteries and other Lead Sources – Accepted at the non-ferrous kiosks. These items cannot be comingled with sheet iron or left in automobiles.
- Oil Filters – Must be drained in accordance with local or federal laws and regulations
